

Andalusian Alpaca Adventure: Farm Life, Flamenco & Flavors

May 11 – May 17, 2026

Shared accommodations | Relaxed pace | Breakfast included daily

Please note: This is a **tentative outline** of the trip. The full itinerary will be finalized together as a group ahead of time so that it reflects everyone's interests and preferences. As a small group, we'll keep the schedule thoughtful, flexible, and low-stress.

May 11 – Departure from the US

Your journey begins today with an overnight flight to Seville, Spain.

May 12 – Arrival in Seville and Transfer to the Farm

Bienvenidos a España! After landing in Seville, we'll take time to stretch our legs, grab a coffee or snack, and then make our way to **Experience Alpacas in Andalucía**, a peaceful countryside farm just outside of Córdoba. Once we've arrived and settled into our shared accommodations, you'll have the afternoon free to rest or explore the farm before a relaxed evening together.

May 13 – Wine Tasting and Slow Farm Morning

After a laid-back breakfast on the farm, we'll ease into the day with a quiet morning. In the afternoon, we're planning to visit **Bodegas El Monte**, a local winery set in the scenic Andalusian countryside, for a wine tasting experience. Afterward, we'll return to the farm for a restful evening.

May 14 – Córdoba Day: City Walk + Flamenco Show

Today we'll spend the day in **Córdoba**. We're planning a **walking tour** of the historic city center, exploring sites like the Jewish Quarter, Roman Bridge, and charming patios. In the evening, we'll attend a live **flamenco performance** at **Tablao El Cardenal**, a passionate and powerful cultural experience. Then we'll head back to the farm for the night.

May 15 – Iberian Farm Experience and Tasting

We'll visit a working farm for a **gastronomic tour** that focuses on sustainable Iberian pig farming. You'll get to sample cured meats and learn about local food traditions. The rest of the day will be free to rest at the farm or explore nearby villages at a relaxed pace.

May 16 – Open Day: Group Choice Adventure

This day is left intentionally open. Depending on the group's preferences, we may return to Córdoba for more exploration, visit another nearby town like **Zuheros** or **Priego de Córdoba**, or simply enjoy a quiet day on the farm. We'll finalize the plan as a group in advance, based on how everyone's feeling.

May 17 – Departure Day

After one last breakfast at the farm, we'll drive to the airport for flights home from **Seville or Madrid** (to be determined).
