Cotswolds: Monday, April 13th - Saturday, April 18th

Monday, April 13: Arrival

It's going to be a wonderful day as you arrive at London Heathrow! I'll be there to greet you, and together we'll make our way to our accommodations where you can unpack and get comfortable. Once you're settled, we'll enjoy a leisurely walk through a nearby village to take in the charm of the Cotswolds before coming together for a welcome dinner at a traditional pub.

Tuesday, April 14: Chipping Campden, Broadway & Stow-on-the-Wold

Spend the morning wandering the historic streets of Chipping Campden. Then take a scenic drive to Broadway, where you can enjoy lunch and browse local shops. In the afternoon, explore Stow-on-the-Wold, with time to admire the famous tree-framed door at St. Edward's Church, visit a cozy tearoom, or take a peaceful countryside walk.

Wednesday, April 15: Bourton-on-the-Water, Bibury & Cirencester

Spend the morning in Bourton-on-the-Water, often called the "Venice of the Cotswolds." Stroll along the River Windrush, cross its charming stone bridges, and visit the delightful Model Village before exploring the local shops. Continue to Bibury, one of England's most picturesque villages, where you can admire the iconic Arlington Row cottages and enjoy lunch beside the River Coln. In the afternoon, visit Cirencester, once the Roman capital of the Cotswolds, to browse independent shops, visit the Corinium Museum*, or relax in the peaceful Abbey Grounds park.

Thursday, April 16: Tetbury, Painswick & Winchcombe

Start your day in Tetbury, known for its antiques and royal connections. Choose to visit one of two beautiful gardens — Highgrove Gardens or Painswick Rococo Garden. Later, enjoy a stroll through the lovely village of Painswick before stopping in the charming town of Winchcombe on the way back.

Friday, April 17: Stratford-upon-Avon

Take a day trip to Stratford-upon-Avon, Shakespeare's birthplace, with time to visit historic sites, wander the town, and enjoy the River Avon and all its beauty.

Saturday, April 18: Travel to Edinburgh

Today we'll drive to London Heathrow to drop off our rental car, then continue our journey by train to Edinburgh, Scotland. Sit back, relax, and enjoy the scenic ride north as we get ready to explore Scotland's rich history, stunning landscapes, and charming towns.





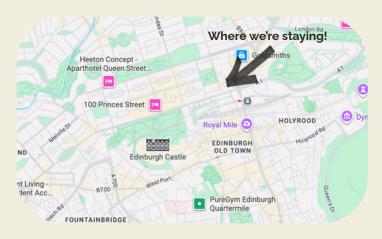






Stay in the heart of Edinburgh

Edinburgh Highlights

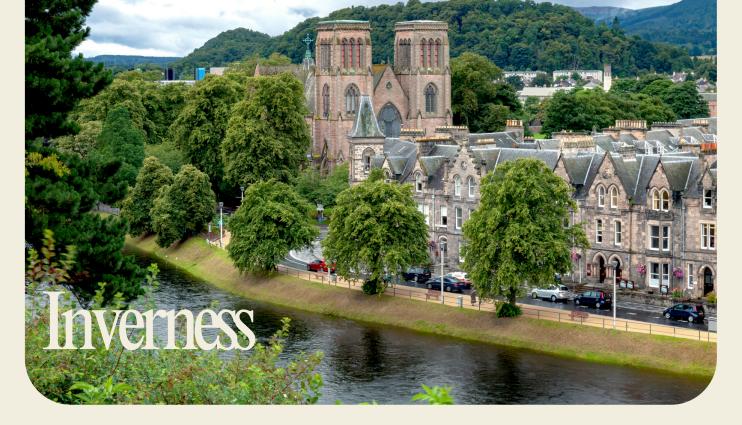
Explore historic sites, scenic viewpoints, cultural experiences, and charming streets in Scotland's capital.

Historic & Cultural Experiences

- Edinburgh Castle: A historic fortress perched on Castle Rock with panoramic city views.
- Palace of Holyroodhouse: The Queen's official residence in Scotland at the foot of the Royal Mile.
- National Museum of Scotland: Exhibits covering Scottish history, culture, and the natural world.
- Royal Mile: Edinburgh's historic main street connecting the castle to Holyrood Palace, lined with shops, pubs, and historic buildings.
- St. Giles' Cathedral: Iconic church on the Royal Mile with stunning architecture.
- Mary King's Close: Preserved underground streets offering a glimpse into 17thcentury life.
- Museum of Childhood: Explore toys and games from different eras.
- The Scotch Whisky Experience: Taste and learn about Scotland's signature drink.
- National Galleries of Scotland: Home to art from Scotland and around the world.

Views & Nature

- Arthur's Seat: Hike this ancient volcano in Holyrood Park for sweeping city views.
- Calton Hill: Central hill with iconic monuments and city panoramas.
- **Royal Botanic Garden Edinburgh:** Stroll through diverse plant collections in this free-to-visit garden.
- **Dean Village:** Picturesque historic village along the Water of Leith, perfect for a relaxing walk.

Inverness is a perfect place to make as a home base for the highlands. We'll be staying within just minutes walking distance to the center of Inverness so travelers can enjoy it on foot and at their leisure!



Monday, April 20: Edinburgh → Aberdeen → Inverness

We'll pick up our rental car in Edinburgh and begin our journey north to Inverness. Our route will take us through Fife, giving us a chance to explore its charming towns before stopping at the dramatic Dunnottar Castle near Aberdeen. Afterward, we continue north along the scenic east coast, taking in the landscape as we make our way toward Inverness.

Tuesday, April 21: Inverness

Friday, April 24: Depart Inverness → Glenfinnan → Glencoe → Glasgow

We'll leave Inverness and travel south, stopping first at the famous Glenfinnan Viaduct lookout. Take in the sweeping views of the viaduct and surrounding landscapes, a perfect spot for photos and soaking in the Highlands. Next, we'll drive through the dramatic landscapes of Glencoe, enjoying its rugged beauty and photo opportunities. Afterward, we continue to Glasgow and check in at Crossbasket Castle, staying in their 5-Bedroom Ensuite Lodge - a truly royal way to end our trip!
